What is the Compass Center?

- The Compass Center envisions a safe and equitable society in which all individuals and families thrive.
- Compass Center was born when two strong agencies with successful track records serving women and families in the community — The Women's Center and the Family Violence Prevention Center of Orange County — merged.
- They provide a unique array of aligned prevention, crisis, and long-term self-sufficiency services under one umbrella.

- 24-hour crisis hotline
- Emergency hotline
- Domestic Violence Crisis Counseling
- Legal Support
- Safety Planning
- Support Groups and Workshops
- Volunteer Training Program

Staff and Volunteers

- Compass Center has 8 staff members, a board of directors, internships, and a volunteer program.
- They have a Domestic Violence Crisis Advocacy Internship that is paid for Fall, Spring, and/or Summer.
- Compass Center serves more than 6,500 clients each year and relies on staff and volunteer support.
- The small staff provides a safe and comfortable environment as we work together towards empowering others and guiding victims of domestic violence towards self-sufficiency
